Therefore, the EU-funded FEDERATE project unites stakeholders to advance SDV research, development, and innovation. The project's mission is to create a collaborative European SDV community involving the mobility sector, open-source software, semiconductor industries, and public bodies. The goal is to establish a clean, affordable, and safe mobility ecosystem across Europe.

- Captured SDV technology, gap analysis, forecasts and glossary
- Refinement of the definition of modular Building Blocks (BBs)
- Creation of prioritized backlog in alignment with other SDV projects and initiatives
- Identification of new standardization initiatives for successfully implemented BBs
- Recommendations created for the realization of BBs
- Aligned recommendations for future SDV calls for EU funding
- Created Vision and Roadmap for realization of the Open SDV Ecosystem
- Organization of European SDV Conferences, hackathons, workshops

Expected impact

- Common understanding (glossary) and wording
